

## Hearing God's Voice Worship Notes

"With a sense that Jesus is by your side, you will have cheerfulness, hope, courage, and joy.... Never, never separate from Jesus. He never separates from us. By the cross of Calvary He has given evidence of his deep love for us. He does not leave us to fight the battle in our own finite strength. He says, 'I will never leave thee nor forsake thee.' Heb. 13:5. Jesus does not cast us off, even when we grieve Him; He clings to us still. Let your heart be animated by the love of Jesus to ardent activity for His glory." OHC 147.

"Satan seeks to draw our minds away from the mighty Helper, to lead us to ponder over our degeneration of soul. But though Jesus sees the guilt of the past, He speaks pardon; and we should not dishonor Him by doubting His love. The feeling of guiltiness must be laid at the foot of the cross, or it will poison the springs of life. When Satan thrusts his threatenings upon you, turn from them, and comfort your soul with the promises of God.... God's children are not to be subject to feelings and emotions. When they fluctuate between hope and fear, the heart of Christ is hurt; for He has given them unmistakable evidence of His love." MYP 109,110.

"When we repent of our transgressions...and resolve to render obedience in the future, we should believe that for Christ's sake God forgives and accepts us, and forgives our sins. We should not cast away our confidence. We must keep the eye fixed on Jesus, feeling or no feeling.... At times a deep sense of our unworthiness will send a thrill of terror through the soul; but this is no evidence that God has changed toward us, or we toward God.... We should by faith grasp the hand of Christ and trust Him as fully in the darkness as in the light." MYP 111,112.

"Be cheerful, and praise the Lord for His lovingkindness. That which you cannot understand, commit to Him. He loves you and pities your every weakness." MYP 109.

"Let us no longer talk of our inefficiency and lack of power. Forgetting the things that are behind, let us press forward in the heavenly way." MYP 108.

"Nothing is apparently more helpless, yet really more invisible, than the soul that feels its nothingness and relies wholly on the merits of the Savior. By prayer, by the study of His word, by faith in His abiding presence, the weakest of human beings may live in contact with the living Christ, and He will hold them by a hand that will never let go." MH 182.
